Scientific Merit

Quality of hypotheses and objectives, independence of objectives, experimental design and methods, data analysis and preliminary data (if applicable). Ability of the proposed research to answer the hypotheses and affect the problem addressed.

Potential Impact

Importance of the study in solving a significant animal health or wider welfare issue, benefits for non-academic stakeholders and strength of stakeholder engagement.

Proposal Quality

Attainability (likelihood of completion in the given timeline, adequacy of expertise, facilities and equipment), grantsmanship, and appropriateness of the budget.

Candidate and Training

Trainee academic strength, career vision and capability to conduct the proposed research. Mentor(s) accomplishment in appropriate fields and capability to mentor this trainee, training plan, facilities and overall research environment.
